Even though the timing of Easter each year has more to do with the moon than with Christ, we as Christians still like to use this time to reflect on Christ's death and resurrection. While the banks close on Good Friday in honor of His death and churches gather early on

Sunday in honor of His resurrection, few seem to do much with Saturday, the day He rested. It is worthwhile to note that at Creation, Jesus rested on the seventh day and rested from all His work. Thus by resting He created a day of rest which all the world recognizes, in as much as we have seven days on our calendar. After we sinned, Christ returned to earth, and lived and died for us. So it was that at the re-creation of man, He rested in the grave on Sabbath and arose on the first day. Yes, it is strange that so many in the Christian world fail to recognize this rest that God provided at Creation and at the re-creation. Could it be that this is one of the reasons why John wrote in Revelation 14:11 that those who worship the beast have no rest day or night?

For the Christian who truly embraces the reality of righteousness by faith, this weekly rest is a symbol of that reality (see Heb. 4.) We rest because we can't help ourselves. We rest because we know firsthand that we can't save ourselves. We rest because He rested in Eden and at Calvary. We rest because He is working on our behalf to apply the blood spilled at Calvary in the courts above. Yes, the Easter celebration is not complete without a celebration of that rest on this Saturday Sabbath.

So it is today as we enter into part five of our six part series entitled "Sunset," that I would like for us to consider the promise for those who rest in Christ. Today as we contemplate Revelation chapter 7, may we celebrate the seal of Christ's authority in our life, the promise that comes with each Sabbath day, that Christ is our Righteousness, our Friend, and our Saviour.
