What Your Adventist Community Services Center did in July 2025: Over 300 households received help with food which included 932 individuals; 20 tons of food went out; 294 people received clothing with a total of 3,835 pieces of clothing; 25 people received financial aid, totaling \$1700; volunteers worked 1,370 hours; 57 new clients applied for help this month; 10 new Bible Studies in addition to those already doing Bible Studies; presently, the money from the gift shop is being used to pay our power bill and office expenses by Board action.
